- Complete and submit application, supporting documents, application fee of \$60 (non-refundable) and unit fees by *Oct. 15, 2025. (Print form or complete online and save to your device.) An incomplete application or diagram will cause a delay in processing.
 *A \$60 late fee is due with the application if submitted after the deadline.

 - B. Permit information DNR, other
 - C. Insurance Information
- 3. Applications are considered at WBLCD Board meetings, held the third Tuesday of each month (except December).
